Bulk Item Guidelines



Conewago Township residents with Basic Service may dispose of one (1) bulk item per week through curb side collection. Please have your bulk item available for collection at the curb by 6:00 am.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS – Appliances (including appliances containing Freon), furniture, mattresses, box springs, one (1) car tire without the rim, lawn mowers (oil and gasoline removed), plumbing fixtures such as toilets and sinks, three (3) 4 ft. rolls of carpet (tied).

NON-ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS – Chemicals, stains, liquids, batteries, automobile parts, hazardous waste, tires on rims, commercial/industrial waste, construction materials (drywall, brick, block, lumber, shingles, tiles, concrete).

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS – Items which are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted. Additional trash bags are NOT considered a bulk item.

Appliances with Freon will be collected by appointment only. Please call Penn Waste at 717-767-4456 to schedule collection. (Items include but are not limited to air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)

Yard Waste Collection Guidelines

Yard Waste is material such as tree trimmings, shrubbery and other organic landscape vegetation not listed below.

How to Prepare Yard Waste

- Place yard waste in biodegradable brown paper bags or bundle it with biodegradable twine in easy-to-handle bundles.
 - Bundles may be no longer than 5 feet in length.
 - · Bundles may not weigh more than 30 pounds each.
 - · Bundles may not exceed 6 inches in diameter.
- 2 Once prepared, yard waste must be placed at the curb on scheduled pick up day before 6:00 am.
- 3 An unlimited number of bags or bundles may be placed at the curb.

Please prepare your yard waste properly. Yard Waste in plastic bags WILL NOT be collected!

BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES

- · Trash, Recycling and one bulk item must be curb side by 6:00 AM on your scheduled collection day.
- · Penn Waste will be delivering mobile carts to basic service customers in late November 2022.
- · Bags or containers should fit within the mobile cart provided.
- · Yard Waste will be collected on the first Saturday of the month, five (5) times per year, (See Calendar Above)
- · Yard Waste must not exceed 5 feet in length and must be bundled.
- · Call Penn Waste to schedule collection of appliances containing Freon (air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- · No construction debris will be collected curb side.



Information About Trash and Recycling Service Days

Effective January 1, 2023, your trash and recycling service days may be changing.



Please reference the included map and street listing to see if your collection day will be remaining on Friday or if it will be moving to Wednesday. Streets north and east of Copenhaffer Road including Copenhaffer except for the section of Copenhaffer that runs west of Big Creek Road (Ward 2) will remain Friday pickup, while south and west (Ward 1) will become Wednesday pickup. Mobile Cart Information

As part of the new contract, Penn Waste will be distributing mobile carts to basic service customers in Conewago Township for Trash service. Mobile carts for recycling have already been distributed in the past. If you are in need of a mobile cart for recycling please contact Penn Waste customer service at 717-767-4456. Mobile cart delivery for trash service is scheduled to begin the last week of November, 2022. You may begin utilizing your mobile cart once it is received.

Basic Service: Customers will receive one (1) 96 gallon mobile cart for trash service. All material should fit in the provided mobile cart.
 If you are in need of excess trash service, extra service bags may be purchased from Penn Waste for \$15.00 per bag.

Penn Waste will be collecting the residents of Conewago Township with an automated side load truck. The utilization of the mobile cart is strongly encouraged. By utilizing the mobile cart, our crews will be able to provide the residents with the most efficient collection for the best price. The mobile carts also reduce the amount of litter and pests within the township.

Mobile Cart Placement

Please be advised that all mobile carts should be placed behind the curb. There should be nothing placed in the roadway that would impede or delay the removal of snow or ice from the road. The garbage truck arm has the capability to reach past the curb in order to pick up your caps. Here are some tips to ensure a smooth collection process:

- Set mobile cart out by 6:00 AM.
- Place mobile cart with the lid handle and wheels pointing toward your residence.
- Do not place cart in the roadway.
- Do not block walkways with carts.

 Place carts at least THREE FEET APART from each other and mailboxes, fire hydrants, low hanging trees or shrubs, parked cars, or utility poles - so trucks can easily access the cart.
