-Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance:

The regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors was held at 490 Copenhaffer Rd. York, PA 17404. The meeting was called to order by the Chairperson Wilhide at 6:00pm. Those in attendance were Lorreta Wilhide (Chairperson), Brian Klinger (Supervisor), John MacDonald (Supervisor), Steve McDonald (solicitor), Lieutenant Neidigh (NYCRPD), Josh Kopp (PWD/Manager), Shanna Housman (Office Administrator), Bethany Inman (Zoning Officer).

-Public Requests: Todd Miller, Dylan Drive, shared a concern about the trash getting picked up too early in the morning or sometimes even very late at night. With the weather being warmer, they have been starting earlier.

Resolution 2025-14: PennDOT Signature Authorization- Motion by Chairperson Wilhide, second by Supervisor MacDonald, unanimously carried to approve Resolution 2025-14.

-Approval of Agenda: Motion by Supervisor Klinger, second by Supervisor MacDonald, unanimously carried to approve the agenda. Vote: 3-0

-Approval of Previous Minutes: Motion by Supervisor MacDonald, second by Supervisor Klinger, unanimously carried to approve the July 2025 minutes. Vote: 3-0

-Planning & Zoning:

-Data Center Text Amendment: Planning Commission is meeting to look over it on August 25th. This is something we were already planning to do with the comp plan. We do not need to approve anything, just a heads up this is coming. We have already had some good conversations about it at the Planning meetings. A data center is a place that houses servers for information for businesses and AI possibly. We must provide a place for it in the Township.

-Official Map: this is a necessary tool for the comp plan. Motion by Supervisor MacDonald, second by Supervisor Klinger, unanimously carried to approve advertisement of the map.

-Hilton Ave: Someone reached out to Bethany, Zoning Officer about giving us a little parcel of land that is in the flood plain. There would not be any maintenance really, just roadside mowing.
